

Reopening of Stratton Audley Church

The PCC are really pleased to announce that the Church will be reopening for people who would like to engage in Private Prayers or simply sit peacefully in the Church. Preparation is underway and we are going to open on Sunday 21st June which is also Father's Day! We expect the Church to be open from 08.00 to 17.00hrs every day.

When the Church opens we would love it to be decorated with flowers - floral arrangements, pot plants or small troughs. It is hoped that we will be able to continue to have such arrangements going forward. If you would like to place your contributions in the Church porch we will put them inside the Church on the window sills, various tables or by the font.

Mike Gore has suggested that photos could also be displayed in the Church for example gardens, flowers, the local area around Stratton Audley and village events. If you would like to have a photo displayed please leave them in the porch (ideally in a simple frame with your name on the back).

Opening is also contingent on us finding a number of volunteers to help for 15 minutes at the end of the day, some time between 17.00 and 18.00. We hope to have enough volunteers that you would only be on duty once every week or fortnight. You would be helping us to make the space as safe as possible by completing a short list of checks and by using a light anti-microbial mist spray on some specific area of likely contact.
